## FNA COMPETITION

For 2021 Fremantle Netball Association will continue to comply with a Netball Australia and Netball WA directive that all players aged from 5 to 10 years old will come under the Net Set Go Banner & Rules. A competition in the SET tier for 7-year-old players will be continued for 2021.

A summary is shown below:

- 7-year-olds (**born 2014**): SET tier (small posts and 10-minute quarters and Net Set Go: SET competition rules).
- 8-year-olds (**born 2013**): SET tier (small posts and 10-minute quarters and Net Set Go: SET competition rules).
- 9-year-olds (**born 2012**): GO tier: (small posts and 10-minute quarters and modified rules).
- 10-year-olds (**born 2011**): GO tier (normal posts and 10-minute quarters and modified rules).
- 11-year-olds upwards (**born 2010 to 2006**): Junior E upwards- Official Rules with finals

All timeslots will allow for 15-minute quarters where required.

GO-G, GO-F & SET tiers will have 10-minute quarters. These games will finish before the other games in the same timeslot.

***Please note:***

1. All Registrations will open on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January** and will close on **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. Registrations received after this date may incur a late penalty fee of \$20.
2. Register by **31<sup>st</sup> January 2021** to gain entry into our early bird prize draw. You could win a new LNC Hoodie for the 2021 season.
3. All on-line registrations must be accompanied with full payment.
4. You are requested to indicate in the on-line registration how you can make a contribution to the Club.
5. Leeming Netball Club seeks to place the strongest team possible in each grade. Please refer to the Club's grading policies in our policy document which can be found on our website.
6. Late registrations may be placed on a waiting list for team selection, in which case no guarantee of team placement can be made.
7. Before completing the Leeming Netball Club player on-line registration process, please read the Terms and Conditions carefully in this document.
8. Umpires will be paid to umpire junior and 17's games during the 2021 Netball Season.
9. During the 2021 season Senior and Under 19 players are required to umpire as part of their team commitment.
10. Players must be fully registered and financial prior to grading.

## HOW TO REGISTER

Leeming Netball Club will open for the 2021 netball season on **11<sup>th</sup> January 2021** and will close on **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021**. The registration link can be found below and on our Facebook Page. Please follow the instructions sent as an attachment with this email to ensure you choose the correct button when registering online for the following age groups:

- Juniors – 2006 to 2010 birth years
- U17s – 2004 and 2005 birth years
- Senior Registration – 2003, 2002 etc.

## Online Registration Instructions

1. Go to the registration link as directed above. Select the appropriate link for your age group (see above).  
This should take you to the club registration welcome page.
2. Select “get started” at the bottom of the page.
3. If you have used My Netball previously you should already have a logon Id. The logon ID can either be your email address or your Netball participant ID. If you don’t have a Login ID select “Continue” and you will be taken to a page where you can do a participant search.
4. Enter your First Name, Last Name and Date of Birth and click FIND ME to search the My Netball database.
5. If one or more matches were found, they will be shown. If the record represents you and an email address has been stored against the record you can click on Email Login to have a username and password emailed to you. If you do not recognise any of the matches found, you can click “Create New Record”.
6. If you have also forgotten your Password, there is a link for Lost Password.

## Once you have logged in:

1. Select the registration products for the correct age group
2. Kidsport – If you have an approved Kidsport voucher number, there is a registration product that will reduce the fees by the amount of the Kidsport voucher. To use this option, you must enter your approved voucher into the appropriate field on the form. 3. **Each family will be required to pay one \$30 fundraising levy** – please ensure this is ticked and paid for during the registration process for **one player only**. You will need to pay this family levy before becoming financial.
4. Select continue and work your way through the form. Note the compulsory questions at the bottom of the form are required by Netball WA and Netball Australia.
5. Select “Continue” and review your order
6. Tick the box that you have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions, then Continue through to payment.

*Please find instructions attached to this email to help you with this process to follow and assist you.*

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To complete your registration, you must agree to the following statement in the on-line registration process. The player and, if the player is less than 18 years old, the first-named parent, each understand and agree as follows:

1. All player particulars must be provided to the Leeming Netball Club on-line. This covers areas such as:
  - Players and parents' names and contact details (please note that the first-named parent will be registered as a "Parent Member" of the Leeming Netball Club)
  - recent playing details and medical conditions
  - proposed contribution to The Club (eg: umpiring, coaching or manager, fundraising, committee or sponsorship)
2. The players will be graded into teams in accordance with Club policy.
3. Leeming Netball Club endorses the Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) Codes of Conduct. Therefore, you are agreeing to abide by these Codes and all other rules, policies and regulations established by the Leeming Netball Club.
4. I give permission for the above details to be used for all administrative tasks within The Club, including the sharing of contact details with coaches, managers and other club officials.
5. I acknowledge that the Leeming Netball Club and/or Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) may from time to time use my or my child's photograph publicly to promote the netball club or FNA. I confirm that by submitting this registration form I am giving the club and/or FNA my permission and authority to use my or my child's photograph publicly to promote the netball club or FNA. I understand that the images may be used in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media. I also understand that no royalty, fee or other compensation shall become payable to me or to my child by FNA or The Club by reason of such use.
6. I agree to participate in the Leeming Netball Club fundraising events.
7. INSURANCE Netball WA financial members are covered by (limited) personal accident insurance.

Players in Seniors and 19's and under, if the player is less than 18 years old, the first-named parent each understand and agree to the following:

*I understand that during the season, including the finals, I will be required to umpire for my team and club. If I am unable to umpire, I understand that it is my responsibility to find a suitable replacement at my own expense. If the Club incurs a fine for "Failure to Umpire" I understand I will be invoiced and will not be a financial member until the account is paid in full.*

As per FNA requirements, grading is based on year of birth, not school year. Every endeavour is made by the Graders to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration skills and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place your daughter with her friends.

If you choose to withdraw your daughter from LNC the following fees will apply:

- Withdrawals after registration and **prior to allocation day** will incur a **\$20 admin fee.**
- Withdrawals **AFTER TEAM ALLOCATION** will incur a **\$50 admin fee.**
- There will be no refund for any withdrawals after the first game.

## TRAINING

All Grading and Training Sessions are held at West Leeming Primary School. Training is held on Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays. Teams will select their training day and time in consultation with the coach.

## COACHING

LNC encourages parents and players to register as coaches. No previous experience is required, and coaches are appointed after discussions with the relevant Coaching Coordinator after grading of the players has been finalised. ## UMPIRING

For every game that LNC plays in the FNA competition, the Club is required to provide an umpire. Players aged 12 and older (including Seniors) who are interested in umpiring juniors are asked to indicate on their registration form that they are interested in umpiring our Juniors. Younger players will not be umpiring on Saturdays but may attend a basic course recommended by the Club. Players wishing to be paid to umpire Juniors will be required to attend one of these courses.

During the 2021 season Senior and 19 and Under division Players are required to umpire as part of their team commitment and those who are lacking in umpiring experience are encouraged to attend any umpiring courses recommended by the club. All club umpires are required to wear a white shirt. FNA imposes a fine of \$50 for failure to umpire, along with a team penalty of 2 premiership points.
