FNA COMPETITION

For 2025 Fremantle Netball Association will continue to comply with a Netball Australia and Netball WA directive that all players aged from 5 to 10 years old will come under the Net Set Go Banner & Rules. A competition in the SET tier for 7-year-old players will be continued for 2025.

Changes were made in 2024 regarding the naming of grades.

The grades are reflected below with relative year of birth noted.

A summary is shown below:

- 7-year-olds (**born 2018**): SET tier (small posts and 10-minute quarters and Net Set Go: SET competition rules).
- 8-year-olds (**born 2017**): SET tier (small posts and 10-minute quarters and Net Set Go: SET competition rules).
- 9-year-olds (**born 2016**): GO tier: (small posts and 10-minute quarters and modified rules).
- 10-year-olds (**born 2015**): GO tier (normal posts and 10-minute quarters and modified rules).
- 11-year-olds upwards to 15 years (**born 2014 to 2010**): -Juniors, Official Rules with finals
- 16's (**born 2009**): FNA registration as Juniors, Official Rules with finals, transition to LNC Seniors
- 18's (**born 2007-2008**): FNA registration as Juniors, Official Rules with finals, part of LNC Seniors
- Open born 2006 onwards: FNA registration as Open, part of LNC Seniors

2025 Playing Timeslots & Allocations: this is *not confirmed yet*, but we will advise once FNA announce their timeslots.

7:45am:	Junior U12 Divisions, possibly some U 11 Divisions or low U13 Division, GO-F High Divisions
9:10am:	Junior U11 Divisions, Junior U13's Divisions, GO-F Low Division, All Abilities
10:35am:	Junior U14, Junior U13 low Divisions, Junior GO-G high Divisions, Net
12.00pm:	U16 low Divisions, Junior U15, GO-G low Divisions (on grass), SET Divisions (grass)
1:25pm:	18U, 16U high Divisions, SET Divisions (on grass)
2:50pm:	Open divisions
4:15pm:	Open divisions

All timeslots will allow for 15-minute quarters where required.

GO-G, GO-F & SET tiers will have 10-minute quarters. These games will finish before the other games in the same timeslot.

Please note:

1. All Registrations will open on 1st of January 2025 and close on 7th February 2025. Registrations after this date will only be accepted after contact with the Registrar on leemingnetballregistrar@gmail.com and where there are available positions in an appropriate grade.
2. All on-line registrations ***must be accompanied with full payment*** and KidSport Voucher numbers if a player qualifies for one. ***Under the new registration platform, late KidSport vouchers cannot be accepted.***
3. Families experiencing genuine financial hardship, should contact the LNC Treasurer on leemingnetballtreasurer@gmail.com to discuss, prior to registration.
4. You are requested to indicate in the on-line registration how you can make a contribution to the Club.
5. Leeming Netball Club seeks to place the strongest team possible in each grade. Please refer to the Club's grading policies in our policy document which can be found on our website.
6. Late registrations may be placed on a waiting list for team selection, in which case no guarantee of team placement can be made.
7. Before completing the Leeming Netball Club player on-line registration process, please read the Terms and Conditions carefully in this document.
8. Umpires will be organized and paid for by LNC to umpire junior and 16's games during the 2025 Netball Season.
9. During the 2025 season, players allocated to 18s and Senior teams are required to umpire (or pay an umpire in addition to their fees) as part of their team commitment.
10. Players must be fully registered and financial prior to grading.

HOW TO REGISTER

Leeming Netball Club will open for the 2025 netball season on **1st January 2025** and will close on **7th of February 2025**. The registration link can be found below and on our Facebook Page. Please follow the instructions sent as an attachment with this email to ensure you choose the correct button when registering online for the following age groups:

- Net Set Go – 2015 to 2018 birth years
- Juniors – 2009 to 2014 birth years
- Senior Registration – 2008 and prior.

Online Registration Instructions

1. Go to the registration link on the PlayHQ website as directed above. Select the correct link for your age group (see above). ***It is very important that you select the correct registration link and type.***
Please note: If you are applying for Kidsport, this must be undertaken before your register, see details below.
2. If this is your first time using PlayHQ, you will need to 'create an account'. If you have used this system previously, please log on and commence registration.

Once you have logged in:

1. Select who you are registering for – yourself or your child.
2. In the 'Choose Role' section – please choose – player. This registration process is currently for players. Registration for coaches will occur when teams are set.
3. Complete participant details.
4. Answer all questions. A number of these questions have been developed by Netball WA and Netball Australia and are mandatory. The LNC has also proposed a number of questions, to assist us in recruiting coaches, team managers and umpires. If you indicated yes to one of these, an LNC Committee member will contact you for further details.
5. Fees – this page will provide you with a breakdown of the costs and payments to Netball Australia, Netball WA, the Fremantle Netball Association and the LNC.

Please note: Netball Australia, Netball WA and FNA are paid directly for your registration. In the event of withdrawing from registration, you will need to abide by their reimbursement policies, see Withdrawals in the document, for more information
6. Products – there are no extra products for the 2025 season.
7. Payment Summary – this page allows you to review your order, summary and add your payment details. It is also where you will need to add in your KidSport voucher number. If you have an approved KidSport voucher number, click on 'I have a government voucher' chose 'KidSport (WA)' enter the voucher code and amount.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To complete your registration, you must agree to the following statement in the on-line registration process.

The player and, if any player is less than 18 years old, the first-named parent, each understand and agree as follows:

1. All player particulars must be provided to the Leeming Netball Club on-line. This covers areas such as:
 - Players and parents' names and contact details (please note that the first-named parent will be registered as a "Parent Member" of the Leeming Netball Club)
 - recent playing details and medical conditions
 - proposed contribution to The Club (eg: umpiring, coaching or manager, fundraising, committee or sponsorship)

2. The players will be graded into teams in accordance with Club policy.
3. Leeming Netball Club endorses the Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) Codes of Conduct. Therefore, you are agreeing to abide by these Codes and all other rules, policies and regulations established by the Leeming Netball Club.
4. I give permission for the above details to be used for all administrative tasks within The Club, including the sharing of contact details with coaches, managers and other club officials.
5. I acknowledge that the Leeming Netball Club and/or Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) may from time to time use my or my child's photograph publicly to promote the netball club or FNA. I confirm that by submitting this registration form I am giving the club and/or FNA my permission and authority to use my or my child's photograph publicly to promote the netball club or FNA. I understand that the images may be used in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media. I also understand that no royalty, fee or other compensation shall become payable to me or to my child by FNA or The Club by reason of such use.
6. I agree to participate in the Leeming Netball Club fundraising events.
7. INSURANCE Netball WA financial members are covered by (limited) personal accident insurance.
8. Players in Seniors and 18's and under, if the player is less than 18 years old, the first-named parent each understand and agree to the following:

I understand that during the season, including the finals, I will be required to umpire for my team and club. If I am unable to umpire, I understand that it is my responsibility to find a suitable replacement at my own expense. If the Club incurs a fine for "Failure to Umpire" I understand I will be invoiced and will not be a financial member until the account is paid in full.

FEES FOR 2025

These amounts cover your Netball Australia fee, Netball WA Affiliation, FNA Registration, LNC Club fees and equipment. FNA and Netball Australia have increased their fees in 2025 by \$10 per player. Due to our fundraising achievements in 2024, we have managed to absorb some of this increase in 2025, meaning a \$5 fee increase only for LNC members.

- Set Players (Born 2017 - 2018), \$295.00
- Go Players (Born 2015 -2016), \$295.00
- Junior Players (Born 2007 -2014) \$305.00
- Senior Players (Born 2007 and prior) \$335.00

PLEASE NOTE: Fees are determined by year of birth, however involvement in the club and allocation to NSG/Juniors or Seniors is dependent on graded team. (For example a 15yr old playing for under 18s will be classed as a Senior and required to pay associated umpiring costs, while their fees will be at the lower rate of a junior.)

PAYMENT METHOD

Pay online by Credit Card/Debit Card and Paypal through PlayHQ. Transaction fees have been included in the registration amount. Follow the prompts to complete the on-line registration. As per FNA requirements, grading is based on year of birth, not school year. Every endeavour is made by the graders to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration skills and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place your child with friends.

PLAYER WITHDRAWAL

If you choose to withdraw your child from LNC, the following fees will apply:

- Withdrawals after registration and prior to allocation day will incur a \$20 administration fee – this is taken out of the Leeming Netball Club's portion of fees. Players will need to refer to Netball WA and Fremantle Netball WA policies, regarding return of their fee portion.
- Withdrawals AFTER TEAM ALLOCATION will incur a \$50 fee, take out of the LNC portion of fees. Players will need to refer to Netball WA and Fremantle Netball WA policies, regarding return of their fee portion
- For withdrawals after the first playing date see LNC's policy of Player Withdrawal.

Allocation advice for all players will be distributed by email on Sunday 9th March 2025.

TRAINING

All Grading and Training Sessions will be held at West Leeming PS unless otherwise advised. Training is held on Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays. Teams will select their training day and time in consultation with the coach.

COACHING

LNC encourages parents and players to register as coaches. No previous experience is required, and coaches are appointed after discussions with the relevant Coaching Coordinator after grading of the players has been finalised. UMPIRING

For every game that LNC plays in the FNA competition, the Club is required to provide an umpire. Players aged 13 and older (including Seniors) who are interested in umpiring juniors are asked to indicate on their registration form that they are interested in umpiring our Juniors. Younger players will not be umpiring on Saturdays but may attend a basic course recommended by the Club. Players wishing to be paid to umpire Juniors will be required to attend one of these courses.

During the 2025 season Seniors Players **(this includes 18U division)** are required to umpire as part of their team commitment and those who are lacking in umpiring experience are encouraged to attend any umpiring courses recommended by the club. All club umpires are required to wear a white shirt and register as an Official in PlayHQ. FNA imposes a fine of \$50 for failure to umpire, along with a team penalty of 2 premiership points.
