

- Leadership & management
 - Attract and retain committee members with a diverse range of skills and experience
 - Monitor and maintain job descriptions for all committee roles with clear annual goals
 - Coaches and officials will be supported as leaders of the club
- Culture
 - Embed our values through behaviours of our committee and members
 - Develop a “Diversity & Inclusion Plan” that clearly defines our club’s role in acknowledging and celebrating diversity in our community
- Membership & Participation
 - Develop and review a club awards system for participants
 - Embed a club wide injury prevention program
 - Develop a uniform standard across the club that represents a professional, united club



Pathways

- Development
 - Develop our physical literacy of fundamental movement skills (throwing, catching, passing)
 - Develop a comprehensive Coaching and Umpire Training Program that provides consistent skill and training plans across all teams
 - Provide integrated player training sessions across all age groups and abilities
- Competition
 - Strive for at least 1 team in A1 division across all age groups
 - Position LNC as a club of choice in the Fremantle Netball Association Competition
 - Grade each team in the appropriate competitive grade across all ages groups
- High Performance
 - Develop and communicate a clear system that leads to high performance for players, coaches and officials at LNC; which is aligned to Netball WA and Fremantle Netball Association
 - Provide support and training to facilitate members to achieve the desired performance level
- Pathways
 - Communicate a progressive pathway approach for players, umpires and coaches with multiple entry points that aligns to Netball WA and Fremantle Netball Association
 - Develop a club based skill pathway for all players through age groups and skill milestones

Sustainability

- Partnerships
 - Develop and annually review a club sponsorship plan
 - Identify, monitor and retain a database of partners that align with the clubs values
 - Develop and maintain strong alignment with City of Melville, Fremantle Netball Association and other organisations that promote netball participation
 - Investigate potential formal relationships with other local sports club
- Communication
 - Develop a communication plan
 - Upgrade the Club's website, letterhead, email and social media platforms with consistent and professional branding
 - Promote clear communication options for members and stakeholders
- Technology
 - Maximise the PlayHQ platform to improve participant data capture
 - Invest in a professional website provider to provide a modern platform for the club
 - Develop and monitor an online merchandise program
- Governance
 - Develop a financial plan to accommodate short and long term planning
 - Develop and implement an annual fundraising plan with clear targets
 - Develop, review and report on all key measures of the club strategic plan
 - Annually review the clubs constitution and club policy manual
- Facilities
 - Develop and maintain relationships with City of Melville, MLA member and other local sports organisations to secure access to "home" floodlit training courts, clubrooms and storage at one site

 - Provide options and opportunities for social, non-competitive participation at all ages and abilities
